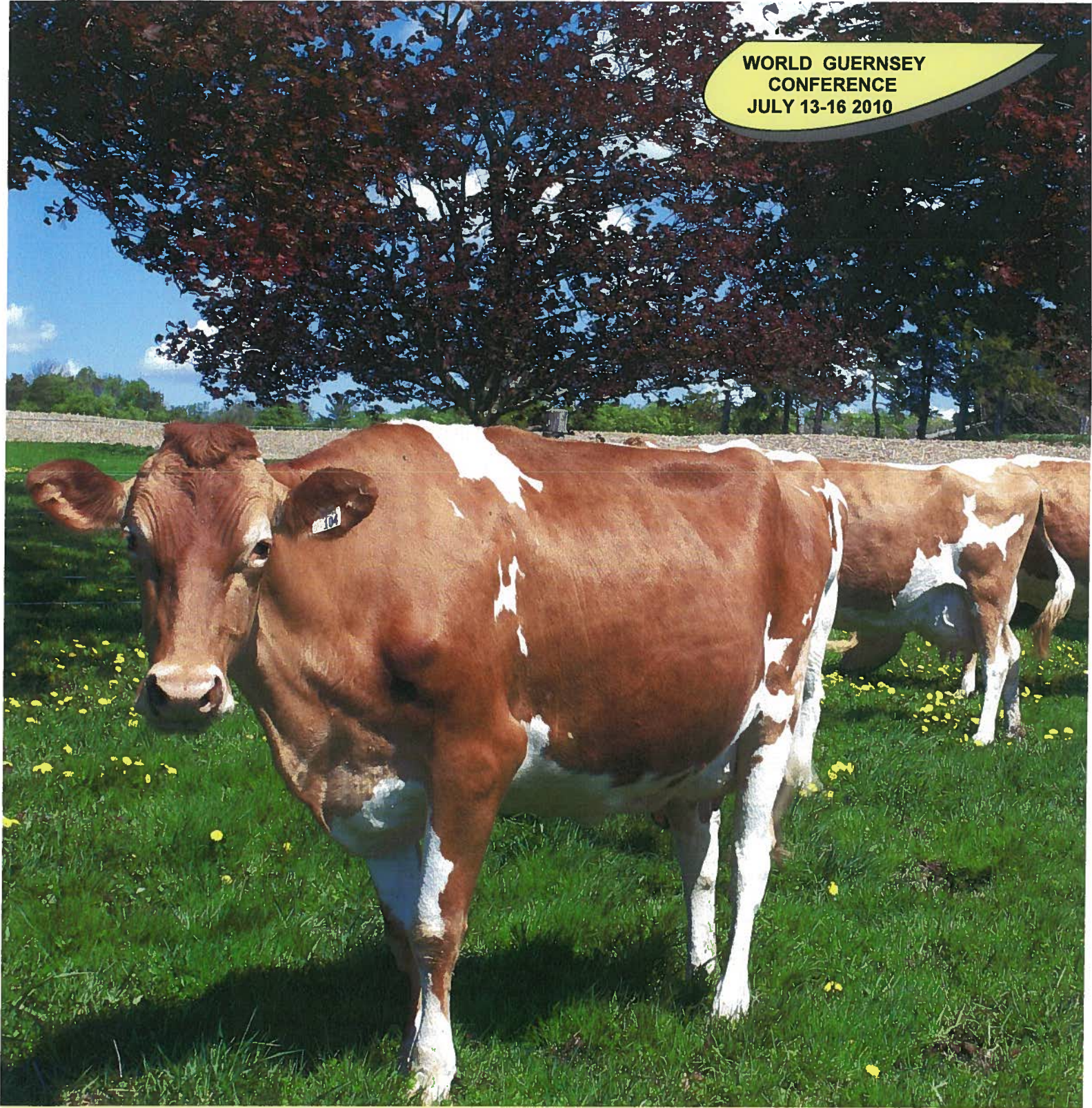

## Canadian and Ontario Guernsey Association Annual Meetings

The Joint Annual Meetings of the Canadian and Ontario Guernsey Association took place on March 26, 2010 at the Gencor offices in Guelph. This was an opportunity for breeders from across the country to come together to celebrate the successes of the breed over the past year as well as project a path for the year ahead.

Brad Royce was the guest speaker. Over the past year, Brad has begun to market Golden Guernsey cheddar. This is a venture that is close to his heart since Brad grew up on a Guernsey farm in Listowel, Ontario and remembers the distinctive attractive golden colour of the milk from the Guernsey cow. The breeders and guests present had the chance to partake in the delicious samples that Brad brought to the meeting. It is no wonder that the product is one of the top sellers at the Countryside Poultry store where both turkey products and cheese are sold. It has a true golden colour with no additives and a smooth texture. Brad also brought several blocks of cheese for purchase which was well received by the attendees.

Guernsey cheese is also marketed by the Upper Canada Cheese Company. Their products include two handcrafted chesses (Comfort Cream and Niagara Gold), a new grilling cheese (Guernsey Girl), as well as cheese curds and ricotta. Their artisan cheese has won awards across North America and has made marketing inroads at the ever popular St. Lawrence Market in Toronto, ON where patrons are always looking for natural products.

Canada is the host for this year's World Guernsey Conference. Marie McNabb, as the Conference Coordinator, has worked hard to ensure that the Conference will be an unforgettable adventure of our spacious country. She outlined that it combines a nice balance of farm tours and tourist destinations that will please all of the delegates. The tour begins in British Columbia on July 3 and continues into Alberta until July 10. The Ontario portion begins on July 11 and continues to July 16 with the Conference taking place in Guelph from July 13-16. The final leg of the tour starts July 17 in Quebec and ends in the Maritimes on July 24. Jim Eby addressed the breeders concerning breed improvement. He was pleased to report that 34% of the animals were classified VG or higher including 8% reaching EX status. On the production side, Jim was proud to report that the breed has eclipsed the 200 BCA mark for protein. He also noted that the National Herd average for milk increased by 150kgs without making any sacrifices to fat or protein percentages. It is important for the Guernsey breed to maintain efficiency and profitability by continuing to strive for a 5% butterfat and a 3.8% protein which can be used as a marketing feature of the breed. Jim also reported on the activities of the Promotions Committee. This new committee was formed to create a greater awareness of the Guernsey breed and effectively promote it. Several ideas have been discussed and we are looking forward to implementing them in the future.

Rob Forster presented the Fieldman Report. The Guernsey National Show held annually during the Ancaster Fair was a success once again. The number of exhibitors increased by two and the number of animals remained constant. The number of participants in the junior showmanship was also unchanged from the previous year at 14. There is been demand for Guernsey cattle in western Canada and we are currently attempting to fill that market. He thanked the breeders for their willingness to take time to show him their Golden Girls and thanked the Board of Directors and Administration for their assistance and direction.

The Semex Sire Report was discussed with the breeders. There is plenty of variety and the future young sires appear to fit the needs of Canadian breeders including sons of Indian Acres Pistachio Pie EX94 who was Supreme Champion at World Dairy Expo in 2007. Rob Forster – Canadian Guernsey Fieldman thanked Murray Reissner who has worked hard on behalf of the breeders to procure superior genetics.

Following the breed reports, production awards were distributed as well as the Gold Star Breeder Awards. The Gold Star Breeders for this year were Ken Forster (Maplehurst Farm) and Jim Eby (Eby Manor Farm Ltd). To achieve this honour, a breeder must have a minimum of 15 completed production records from homebred animals that have achieved an average classification score of 82.5% and BCA's that are 10 points higher than the National Herd Average. Congratulations to both breeders! The meeting would not be complete without the annual auction. The auction raised \$810 for the Guernsey Association. Many thanks go to the companies and individuals that contributed items to the auction.

The Board of Directors elected Scott Gordon (Don Haven Guernseys) as the Ontario President. Leith West (Beaverwood Farm) of Dundas, NB continues his term as the Canadian President.

The Guernsey breed can be proud of the achievements of the past year and look forward to building upon the foundation for many years to come.

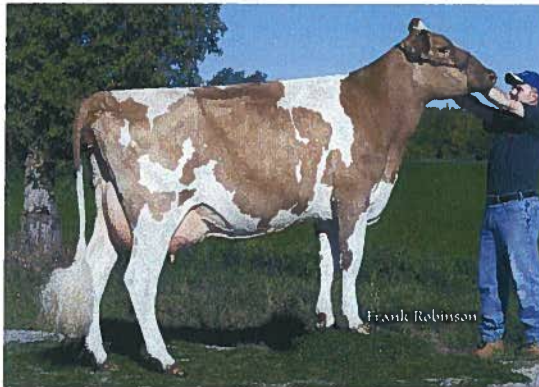

## EBY LAWN EBYBROOK DELTA MEL

A news release from the American Guernsey Association stated that the official placing of the NGS- Madison, held in October 2009, have been amended to reflect the exclusion from the show of the Junior Champion and winning fall Calf – Eby Lawn EbyBrook Delta Mel. Mel was exhibited by Eby Lawn Farms and EbyBrook Holsteins of Listowel, Ontario. Following the show, it was determined through DNA testing that she was not sired by Four Winds Royal Delta. All animals that competed directly with this calf have been moved up one place in their show placings including each Fall Calf.

A second DNA test requested by Canadian Guernsey Association officials confirmed that Eby lawn EbyBrook Delta Mel was not sired by Four Winds Royal Delta, and further testing confirmed that she was sired by a Red & White Holstein. Pursuant to the results of the parentage verification of Eby Lawn EbyBrook Delta Mel the CLRC has suspended her registration status.



## Fieldman Report Summer 2010

The 31st annual Blue Halter Sale is in the books. There were 36 animals available for the sale with some that will make an impact at show rings this fall. Even considering the economic times, this sale continues to have top rate animals consigned. There was a balance in the numbers of calves and breed heifers offered as well as a balance of sale prices. The overall average was \$2176 with the top animal selling for \$4000.

A big thanks goes out to all of the consignors for offering these high quality animals.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to Martha Turley who suffered a stroke the morning of the Blue Halter Sale and to Jim Trotter who had a lung infection. Both Martha and Jim are both strong willed people on the road to recovery who have supported the Guernsey breed for decades and we wish them well.

I recently had the opportunity to visit Eastern Ontario and Quebec. My first stop was at Bonnie Glen Guernseys owned by Robert and Julie Mason. Although few in numbers, they are happy with the Guernseys and crossed several Holsteins with Guernsey sires. The Masons are looking forward to World Guernsey Conference visitors in July.

The next stop was at Ferme Sorel Senc owned by Serge and Carole Girard. Their herd consisted of breeds of all colours except a Guernsey. But that all changed last September when they purchased Maplehurst Bolero Bessie, a Millborne Bolero daughter from the 2X Canadian National Champion Maplehurst Golden Bess Ex-92. In October, Bessie produced a stylish Mentor daughter. She currently is on pace to produce 8833kgs milk 424kgsF 298kgsP and was raised to VG-88.

En route to Ottawa I stopped at Redngold Guernseys owned by Alan Spence. He continues to praise his Guernseys. One cow in particular is quite impressive – Redngold Tradition Parfait VG-85 is an extremely dairy and well balanced individual. She is not only pretty but has super production as well with a 4 year old record of 9901kgs 481F 351P. Alan also has a recently fresh Spring Walk Stone-ET daughter who has good udder attachments with correct teat placement.

A trip to Ottawa would not be complete without a stop at the Agricultural Museum which is managed by Brent Corrigan. The Museum is currently home to 3 Guernseys and is an opportunity to showcase our breed to international visitors.

As I ventured north, I visited the Straathof family farm in Westmeath, ON just outside of Pembroke, ON. Adrian showed me the single Guernsey that they currently own. She is a 50% registered daughter from the Marshdene herd of South Western Ontario whose sire will be determined in order to change the status of this strong dairy cow to purebred.

Many of you have received the flyer for the newly released proven sire Sniders Tiller Altanic. This new addition adds yet another son of Cedar Fringed Altann to an already impressive Select Sires lineup that consists of her sons Alstar and Aaron. Consider using Altanic to increase milk production and type, but protect on rump angle as he can sire daughters with high pins.

The most recent available young sires are:

1. Springhill Judgement-ET - This is an Aaron son from Tiller Joke who was the Grand Champion at Louisville in 2009. This bull combines a nice balance of type and production. Judgement is available through Semex.
2. Springhill Jackpot-ET - Jackpot is a full brother to Judgement. He is available through Select Sires.
3. Indian Acres Pies-ET - Pies is a Challenge son from the infamous Pistachio Pie who was Supreme Champion at Harrisburg and Madison in 2007. He is available from St. Jacobs ABC/ABS.
4. Idle Gold J King Caspian-ET – Caspian will to be available July 1 through Semex. He is little bit of an outcross as he is sired by Twin Brook Enhancer Jonah-ET. Jonah is known to sire animals with very good udders and crossed with Idle Gold Royal Contessa who is a former #1 cow in the U.S. Caspian could be bull to use to satisfy many breeders.

All of these bulls demand consideration for your breeding program.

Are there any cows that you are considering flushing?? If we are able to make potential buyers aware of the quality of donor cows that we have available then a buyer can choose the mating of their choice. This also enables embryos to be sold faster because the market will already be secured and allows the breeder to avoid storage costs and flushing fees for a slow external market. However, I am not discouraging any breeder from flushing top cows in your herd and implanting embryos in your own animals for genetic improvement. This option should always be considered.

Do you have your prospects chosen for the upcoming 2010 Canadian National Guernsey Show? Many of us are busy but it is never too early to prepare your girls for the highlight of the year. This is an opportunity to showcase the only dairy breed show other than 4-H at the Ancaster Fair. Keep in mind that there will be Guernsey show at the Rockton World's Fair on Thanksgiving Monday. This is the first time in a long time that Guernseys have been shown at Rockton and it would be nice to make a large splash.

I would to thank all of the host breeders in advance for opening up their doors to the delegates of the World Guernsey Conference. This is a great opportunity to display your "Golden Girls" and be an example of what Canada has to offer. I hope to visit with current Guernsey friends and meet new ones.

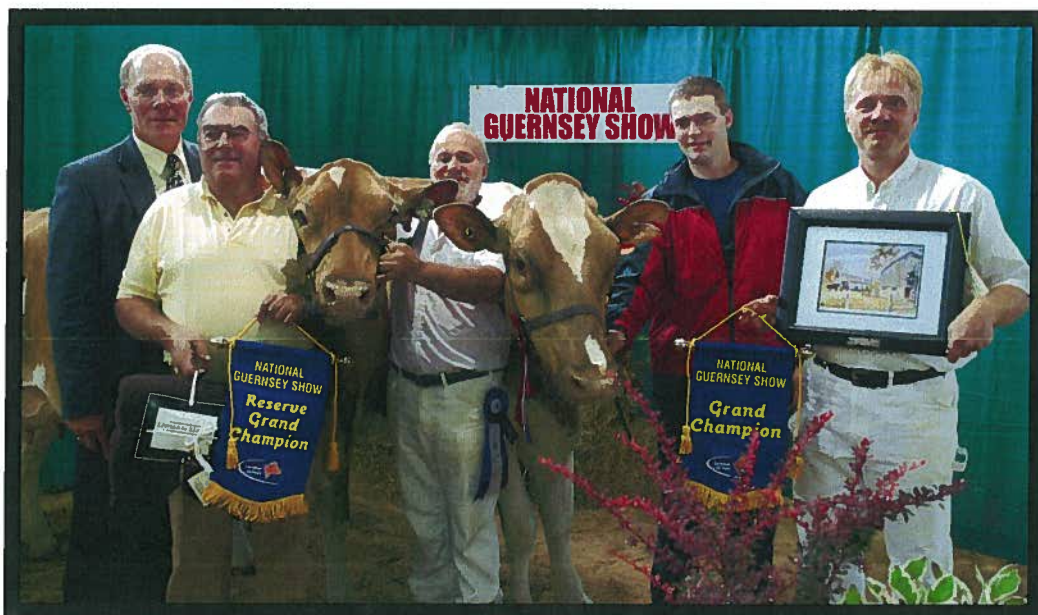

**For the Canadian Guernsey Association..... information about Angus McNabb's donation of an historic outhouse to Westfield Heritage Village in Rockton, Ontario.**

Old historic log outhouses are probably few and far between in Ontario, but at one time they existed on many farms where they fulfilled an important role. Knowing the historic importance of these buildings, Guelph area resident Angus McNabb decided to save an old historic outhouse for posterity. The former member of the Canadian Guernsey Association donated a log outhouse circa 1845 to Westfield Heritage Village in 1974. Some time in the summer of that year the outhouse was dismantled and then re-erected at the Village where it still stands today, one of over 30 historic buildings on site at Westfield. Westfield, which was originally established by two Brantford area school teachers, Glenn Kilmer and Goldie MacDonell, is a heritage village that preserves and presents 19<sup>th</sup> century rural life in Upper Canada.

This outhouse was originally situated on the site of Angus McNabb's old farm off Silvercreek Parkway near Marden Road north of Guelph in Guelph Township. The farmhouse where Angus McNabb once lived still exists on the property, but of course the log outhouse is gone. The outhouse, according to early records kept by Westfield, was "a very roomy two-holer".

Angus, who died some time in the 1980s, once owned a farm on part of Lots 12, 13, and 14 on Concession 4, Guelph Township, Wellington County. A relative of Angus's believes the outhouse was located somewhere behind the farmhouse that still stands off Silvercreek Parkway. It's possible that this was not the original location of the outhouse since the building was apparently moved while still on the farm. As noted in Westfield's early records, the building was "relocated on the farm at least three times."

Angus, who has been described by relatives as a quiet unassuming man, made a significant contribution to preserving a little piece of Ontario's rural history. We have him to thank for making this donation and for ensuring that people today can still see an old-fashioned outhouse of the type that once existed on many Ontario farms.
