CCIA TAGGING REQUIREMENTS

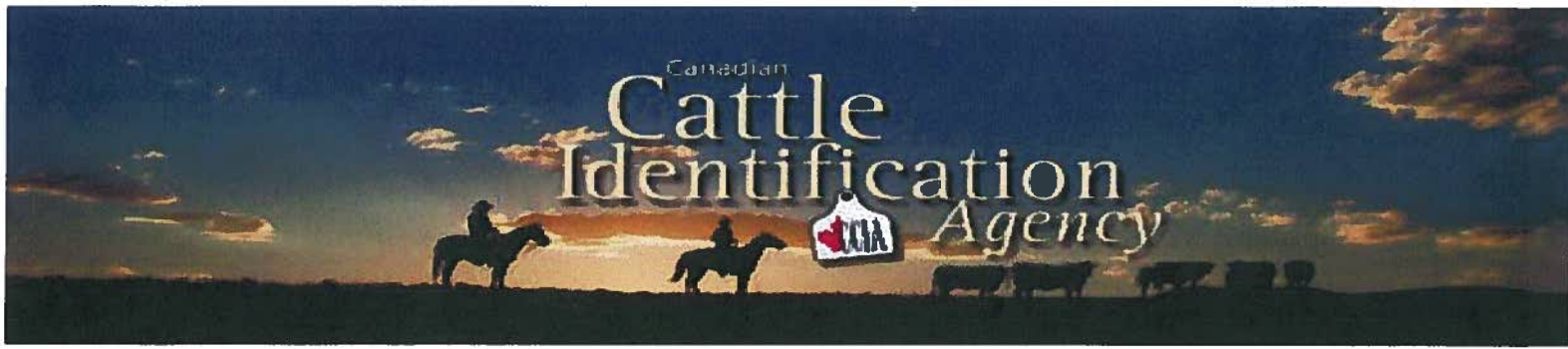


As of January 1, 2010

All cattle must be tagged with a CCIA approved RFID tag.
DO NOT remove existing bar code tags in animals.

Leave the bar code tag in AND apply an
RFID tag to the same animal.

PLEASE NOTE: Tampering with and/or cutting out a
CCIA approved tag is against regulations.



CCIA Tag Standards and Specifications

The Canadian Cattle Identification Agency has implemented national standards for the approval of bar coded and RFID tags into the Canadian Cattle Identification Program. Electronic bar code scanners and RFID readers can be used to efficiently collect tag numbers while maintaining the integrity of the information for submission to the National database.

Bar Coded Tags



- The bar codes on approved tags must be one of two symbologies; Code 128 or Interleaved 2 of 5. All bar code symbologies have been designed for specific performance characteristics. Code 128 and Interleaved 2 of 5 are compact symbologies that demonstrate superior performance when applied to limited space such as a dangle tag.
- Each bar code must be encoded with one of three prefix character sets to identify the country of origin;
 - 124, 0124, or CAN = Country Code
- The bar coded tags used for Beef, Bison, and Sheep encode a nine digit animal identification number assigned by CCIA to the manufacturer. This nine digit number will follow one of the above mentioned prefix character sets. The animal identification number assigned for Dairy cattle may consist of 7 or 8 digits, with leading zeros being encoded between the country code and identification number, meeting the nine digit criterion.
- All nine digits (including any lead zeros) of the animal identification number must be printed in the human readable form. The country code must be embedded in the bar code but must not appear in the human readable number.
 - i.e. human readable form is 299999999. The electronic readable form is 124299999999, 0124299999999, or CAN299999999.

- Bar coded tags that were manufactured at the beginning of the CCIA program may also be displayed electronically as 124000299999999. This format is also acceptable.
- Check Digits- Code 128 uses a mandatory single digit at the end of the encoded numbers to verify that all electronic data has been read correctly. The reader will calculate a check digit for verification to the check digit read within the bar code. The check digit will be displayed in numerical form at the end of the identification number, creating a 10th digit after the country code.
 - i.e. 1242999999990.
- Electronically collected bar code numbers being submitted to the CCIA database for retirement upon death or export can be accepted in the form that they are read by the readers. Please see *Instructions for building files to submit directly to the CCIA database*.
- All approved CCIA bar coded tags visibly display a printed bar code, a nine digit identification number, and the logo of a three quarter maple leaf and the letters CA.

Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Tags



- All RFID tag numbers are 15 digits, with the lead 124 country code and the 12 digit unique identification number. This unique identification number will consist of three lead zeros and the nine digit number allocated to tag manufacturers by the CCIA.
 - i.e. 124000299999999.
- The number printed on the tag must be the same number as imbedded in the transponder.
- All electronic reads and tag number submissions to the CCIA database must be in the approved format.
 - Other approved RFID tags, although no longer manufactured, may be white in colour .
- Unless otherwise specified in this document, all approved CCIA RFID tags are yellow in colour, are printed with a 15 digit identification number beginning with the 124 country code, and bear the CCIA logo of a three quarter maple leaf and the letters CA. RFID tags do not have a check digit as in bar code symbologies.

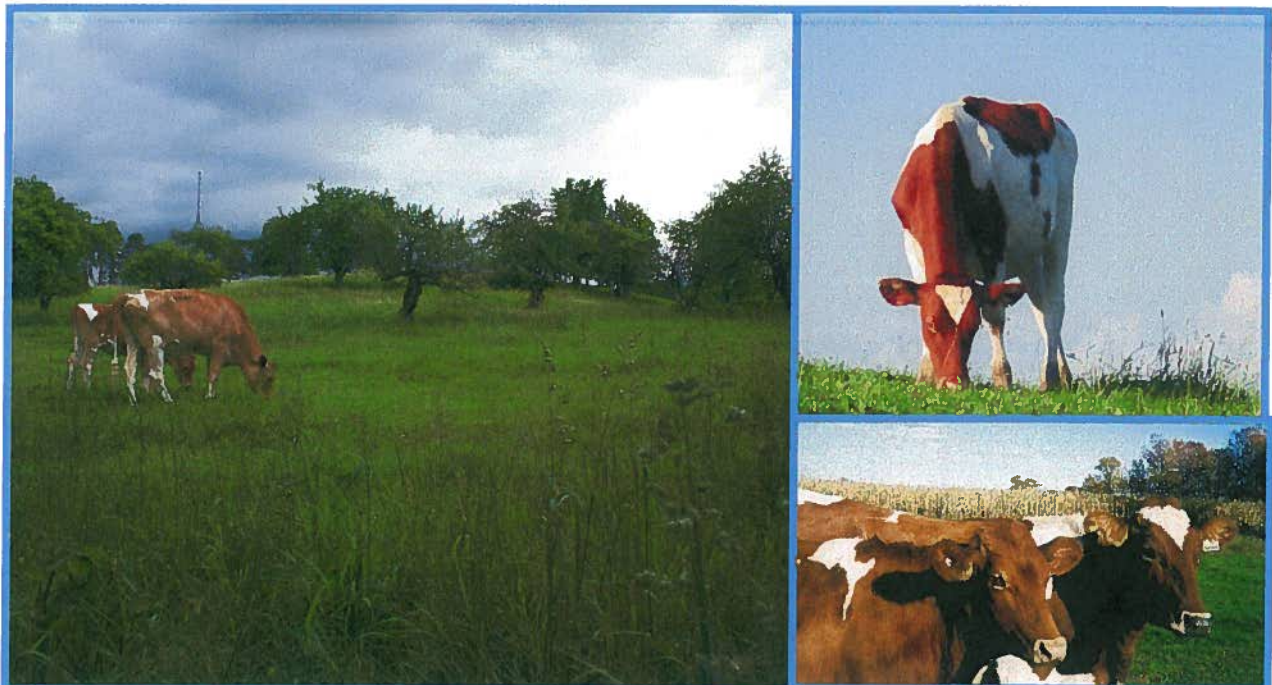

JOHN KUDELKA – 1914 – 2009

GLENVILLE FARMS

John Kudelka passed away December 11, 2009 at Southlake Regional Health Centre in Newmarket, Ontario. He was long known in the area through his work for Glenville Farms, Greenshields, Crang and Ostiguy, Richardson Securities (now RBC Securities) and the Liberal Party of Canada. John was born in Budapest, Hungary and arrived in Canada in 1932 with his parents, Sandor & Rose. In April 1939 John attended the Ontario Agricultural College in Guelph, Ontario. When the school was taken over by the RCAF in 1941 at the end of his 2nd year, he worked for Eaton's chicken farm until enlisting in the Canadian Army in 1943. After serving in the Canadian forces of occupation in Germany he was discharged from the army in 1946. When he returned to Canada, he finished his BSA degree and became farm manager at Glenville Farms, Newmarket, Ontario. Glenville Guernseys originated in 1948 with one cow and John as the new farm manager. With well planned purchases in Canada and the United States, John and his employer, J.H. Crang, built Glenville into one of the largest and best herds in the country. John married Kathleen Mary Kellington of Stouffville, Ontario and they raised six children: Peter, Phillip, Janet Rose, Matthew, James and Frances. When Kay passed away in 1983, John left the farm. By that time Glenville had grown from the original 300 acres to over 1000 acres. He operated Glenville Farms Dairy, which distributed Guernsey milk exclusively, and eventually opened a brokerage office for J.H. Crang and Company in Newmarket. During his career at Glenville Farms, John became President in 1978 -1979 of the Ontario and Canadian Guernsey Breeders Associations, and traveled from coast to coast in Canada. He also judged the Guernsey show in Nairobi, Kenya. John was active in the Liberal Party of Canada, Chairman of the Aurora-Newmarket Family Life Centre and Director of the Big Brothers Association of York Region. He was a member of the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto. He was Chairman of the Sharon Festival of Music, and throughout his life was an enthusiastic art collector and patron of the arts. In 1978 he was the recipient of the Queen's Silver Jubilee Medal. He married Carol "Cleo" Rose in 1984 and became her mentor and traveling companion. By marrying Cleo he acquired two more daughters: Deanna and Rosanne, and was grandfather to their children. Besides his wife Kay, he was predeceased by his parents, and his second son Phillip. He is survived by Peter (Thelma), Janet Rose, Matthew (Deborah Anna), James, and Frances, six grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren. The fieldstone marking his grave is from Glenville Farms. John will be remembered by his many friends and acquaintances in the Guernsey circle!

HOWARD LINDSAY – 1922- 2009

Howard Lindsay passed away December 8, 2009 at the West Haldimand Hospital, Hagersville, Ontario. Howard spent all of his 87 years on the Farm at Selkirk. Rumor has it that he was born on the kitchen table. Born August 29, 1922 Howard was the youngest of 5 children. He married Eunice (Hughes) October 18, 1947. They were blessed with two children Bonnie and Dave (Sheila). Howard worked for the Gas company then a Lindsay Home Hardware while farming. They purchased their first Guernsey from George Bassindale in the 60's and built the herd from them. By the time Dave graduated from Fanshaw with his Farm Business Management diploma the herd was 100% Registered Guernseys and Howard was able to go back to full time



farming. The cattle were shown at fairs by Ken Mulkins, Howard sold replacement heifers, sponsored the Guernsey Classic Sale, twilight meetings and Club picnics. He always welcomed visitors. Even after the grandchildren were around to take over many of his duties, he and the farm dogs were up bright and early to put the cows in, turn the washer on and scrape up. The last 3 months he was in the hospital was the longest period of time he spent away from the farm.
