## CDN Genetic Evaluation Highlights

"Bianca" Daughter-Dam Pair Excel in the Guernsey Breed Although the list of Top LPI cows is still led by the trio of Glen Haven Lewis Lana (#1 LPI), Guernsey View Kit's Ruby (#2) and Maplehurst Lewis Brea (#3), it is Maplehurst Aarons Bianca that raises eyebrows as the highest newly indexed cow this round arriving at #4 LPI (#1 Fat), just 74 LPI points ahead of her dam Maplehurst Warden Bianca at #5 LPI. Three other newly indexed cows penetrate the Top 25 LPI list, including full sister daughters of Lindrian Pizzaz (#27 LPI), namely Lindrian Aaron Penny One (#9 LPI) and Lindrian Aaron Penny Two (#18

LPI), as well as Eby Manor Aaron Wacey at #24 LPI (#2 Fat). The list of Top 10 LPI bulls includes the same list as last round headed by Trotacre Enhancer Lewis ET at #1 LPI, followed by Jordan, Double L and Bingo in that order. Millborne Bolero holds tight regardless the base change and jumps to take #5 LPI from #10. Last round's newcomer, Land Of Living RO Levi-ET, drops for production, increases for Conformation and experiences a net LPI decrease of 311 points, landing at #18 LPI from #11. Spring Walk Stone (Glacier x Tiller) is the sole young sire graduate this round arriving at #19 LPI.

### Gold Star Dam Requirements

#### Qualifications

- No points will be allotted for the dam herself
- No points for the sire
- Minimum of two daughters
- Embryo transfer daughters will have equal points as natural
- Qualifying daughters must classify at least Good Plus and average plus deviations to the herd on total records
- Additional points will be added for daughters who meet production standards and/or type classification
- Eight (8) points are required for Gold Star Dam
- Each additional eight (8) points would add 1 star

#### Procedures

- Breeder must apply for the Gold Star Award
- \$5.00 fee
- Award – Certificate at Annual Meeting

# Fieldman Report - Spring 2011

Although warm weather is slow to appear this year, it sure has heated up in the auction ring. In the past 2 months there have been two hot sales. On March 26th, the sale of the century took place at the Four Winds Dispersal whose history has been well documented. This is the end of an era for Clark and Joy Vilter but the beginning of new ones for the purchasers of these fine animals from this extraordinary herd. The sale average was just over \$5000 with 3 animals selling over \$12000 and 3 more selling for over \$10000.

The sale results can be found at <http://www.usguernsey.com/fourwinds.htm>. The most recent sale took place on April 16th in Bedford, PA called the Blue Halter Sale. This sale has been the source of many All-Americans as well as foundation animals like Cedar Fringed Altann who is dam of Aaron, Alstar and Altanic and 7 Excellent daughters. Also, it is of significance because Ontario breeders have the opportunity to consign animals to this prestigious sale. This year five animals were consigned and they did not disappoint. The sale topper (\$11000) was a choice of 5 Mar Ral Tiller Mission daughters (due on June 1) from none other than Cedar Fringed Altann. The highest live animal was Maplehurst Altanic Bounty (\$7200) consigned by Maplehurst Farm of Lynden, ON. Bounty is a fall yearling from an excellent Magicman and placed first in the fall calf class at last year's Canadian National Guernsey Show. This sale average of \$3249 on 44 lots was the second highest average for the Blue Halter Sale.

2011 promises to be an exciting year for young sire releases. Indian Acres Pies Patriot ET will be released in May/June. He is a Sniders Loral Goldust son from the 2007 Expo Supreme Champion Pistachio Pie. Following Patriot will be the release an Aaron son from Lindrian Garrett Pippy 465 EX92 (90/94), Lindrian Python Aaron 216. Pippy has a 4yr old record of over 27000 pounds of milk at 6.0% butterfat. She is on pace to complete her 6 yr old record with over 31000 pounds of milk at 5.2% butterfat. Patriot and Python Aaron will be available through Semex. Later this year Semex will release a Lang Haven Decision Natural son from Lang Haven Tiller Nevaeh who is a full sister to Lang Haven Tiller Nirvana.

Breeders will now have this chance to access Natural blood since his semen is unavailable in Canada.

Select Sires has released Flambeau Manor YB Lynndell who is sired by Yogibear from a maternal EX 91 sister of Tiller Les with records over 28000 pounds and 5.7% butterfat. Welcome Hillpoint N Popeye is another sire that has just been released by Select Sires. He is another Lang Haven Decision Natural son from a VG-89 Tiller daughter who was All-American 2 year old in 2007 with records over 24000 pounds and 5.0% butterfat. Later this summer, Select is expected to release a Flambeau Manor Tiller Les son from Marodore Alstar Laura who is from the same maternal family as Marodore Logic Lainey EX93 (the dam of Maplehurst Tiller Lane). These young sires are definitely worth consideration for your breeding program as they combine production, components and longevity.

Spring Walk Stone received his first proof in the April evaluations. This initial proof (24 daughters) indicates that Stone is a component improver however with only a slight positive for milk at +100kgs. His Canadian type proof is still preliminary with only 13 classified daughters, but indicates negative values on all major traits. His next proof will provide more reliable information.

Land of Living RO Levi has just completed his second evaluation which is quite eye opening. He boasts high numbers in all major type traits with 76% of his daughters scoring 80 points or more. They are very easy to spot in every herd I have visited as they show extreme dairy strength and angularity. Levi daughters could be the ones to beat in the show ring on both sides of the border.

I would like to hear from you, the Guernsey breeder, with any suggestions or concerns that you may have to make us better. In order to advance the breed, input is necessary from everyone who has a vested interest in the Guernsey Association. The Board of Directors and the Fieldman help steer the ship but it is the members and breeders that provide the power to move the ship ahead.

Each year, the genetic base used to express genetic evaluations in Canada is updated in conjunction with the first official release. The definition of each genetic base used is therefore as follows:

Coloured	Conformation	Proven bulls born in the most recent complete 15-year period (1991 to 2005). For Canadienne and Milking Shorthorn breeds, the base period starts with proven bulls born in 1984.
